XXVII. And be it enacted, That the courses and lengths of the said boundary lines, so ascertained and established, shall on all 10 occasions be and be taken to be the true courses and lengths of the boundary lines of the said Townships and Concessions, in Upper Canada whether the same do or do not, on actual survey, co-incide with the 15 courses and lengths in any Letters Patent of Grant or other Instrument mentioned and expressed in respect of such boundary lines.

XXVIII. And be it enacted, That if any 20 person or persons shall knowingly and wilfully pull down, deface, alter or remove any such monument so erected as aforesaid, in Upper Canada, such person or persons shall be adjudged guilty of felony; and if any per- 25 son or persons shall knowingly and wilfully deface, alter or remove any other landmark, post, or monument placed by any Land Surveyor, to mark any limit, boundary or angle of any Township, Concession, range, lot or 30 parcel of land, in Upper or in Lower Canada, such person or persons shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and being convicted thereof before any competent Court, shall be liable to be punished by fine or imprison- 35 ment or both, at the discretion of such Court, such fine not to exceed and such imprisonment not to be for a longer period than months, without any prejudice to any civil remedy which any 40 party may have against such offender or offenders in damages, by reason of such offence; Provided that nothing herein contained shall
