An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money required for defraying certain expenses of the Civil Government and other purposes, for the year 1863, for making good certain sums expended for the public service in 1862, and for raising a Loan on the Credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Most Gracious Sovereign:

THEREAS it appears by Messages from His Excellency Preamble. the Right Honorable Charles Stanley Viscount Monck, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over this Province of 5 Canada, and the Estimates accompanying the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Civil Government of this Province and of the Public Service thereof, and other purposes, for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three and to make good 10 certain sums expended for the Public Service, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two :- May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of 15 Canada, that-

- 1. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this \$3,909,454 37 Province, there shall and may be paid and applied a sum not granted out of exceeding in the whole three millions, nine hundred and nine Revenue Fund. thousand, four hundred and fifty-four dollars, and thirty-seven 20 cents, for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Province for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and not otherwise provided for, and to make good certain sums expended for the Public Service in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, 25 and for other purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
- 2. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to autho- Loan of \$1,500, rize the raising, by way of loan on the credit of the Consolida- 000 authorized. ted Revenue Fund of this Province, a sum not exceeding one million five hundred thousand dollars, to be placed to the credit 30 of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund, towards making good the sums charged upon the said Fund by this Act, for the · Public Service.
