CAP. XVI.

An Act to revive and continue, until Thirty Days after the Commencement of the next Sellion of Parliament, an Act, passed in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, Chapter Seventy-fix, videlicet, on the Seventeenth Day of June One thousand seven hundred and ninetythree, intituled, An AEt for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of Newfoundland, and the Islands adjacent. [9th January 1799.]

THEREAS the Law herein-after mentioned has, by Experience, Preamble. been found uleful and beneficial, and it is therefore expedient that the fame fhould be revived, and further continued, be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That an AA, made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His prefent 33 Ge. 11, Majefty, intituled, An AA for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Cap. 76, Hand of Newfoundland, and the Islands adjacent, which was to continue revived and in force until the Tenth Day of June One thousand seven hundred and continued un-ninety-four, and from thence to the End of the then next Selfion of Par-after the Comliament, and which, by Three Acts of the Thirty-fourth, Thirty-fifth, the next Seiand fion.
