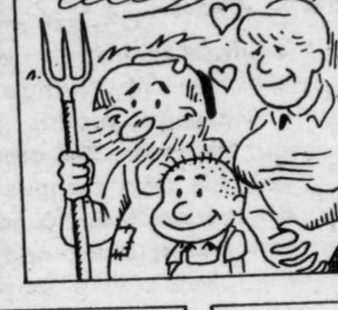

Over one hundred people from every single province attended the recently joint conference between the Canadian and Atlantic Undergraduate Physics Conferences (20 CUPC - AUPC '84)

According to Ian Hartley, the chairman of the joint conference, the activities "ran very smoothly". Dan Hurley, president of the UNB Physics Society pointed out that "A lot of people helped out" which no doubt helped in the smooth operation of the various events.

This is only the second time that the CUPC has been held in the Maritimes and the first time it has been held at UNB.

According to some literature provided by the organizers "The primary objective of this conference is to bring together as many of the undergraduate physics students across Canada, so that they may exchange ideas and mingle with active research physicists and fellow students from near and far."

One aspect of the conference is the presentation of papers by students. At this year's national conference, Atlantic students presented

the majority of the papers.

Another important aspect of the conference is the lectures by guest speakers. Dr. S.L. Chin, University Laval (laser optics); Dr. M. Rochester, Memorial University (geophysics); Mr. C. Trum, Spar Aerospace (Canada in space); Dr. J. Wheeler, University of Texas (theoretical physics); and Dr. C. Young, University of New Brunswick (atmospheric physics) were some of the guest speakers.

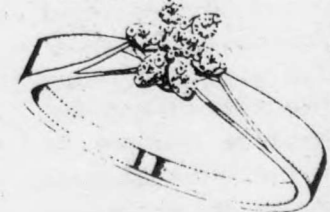
