In reply to your letter of the 10th instant, I beg to say that the Department is much pleased to learn of the very satisfactory results of the wheat and oat crop respectively at the Peigan Reserve, and also in regard to the timothy.

The Department notes your recommendation that all the timothy seed grown be taken over by the Department from the growers at .5¢ per lb. with a view to using the same for seeding purposes in the Spring. Kindly instruct the Indian Agent to purchase all the timothy seed from the Indians at the price stated.
