



Ottawa, February 9th., 1916.

Sir,-

I have to request that you will forward to the Department without delay a statement of the number of cases of convictions and penalties imposed by you in the courts, during the year ended 31st December 1915 for infraction of any clauses of the Indian Act. The statement should give the date of the trial, the name of the person against whom the charge was brought, and the fine or penalty imposed. It should also show to whom a moiety of each fine was paid, and there should be attached to the statement receipts from the respective individuals paid, whether Dominion or Provincial constables or other persons. In future these statements should be forwarded quarterly.
