United Nations; Canadian member of Board of Auditors

1. The Secretary of State for External Affairs reported that a request had been received for concurrence in the appointment of the "chief audit official" of the Canadian government to the United Nations Board of Auditors for the period January 1st, 1947, to June 30th, 1950.

It was recommended that concurrence be given.

2. The Cabinet, after discussion, approved the Minister's recommendation and agreed that the Auditor General of Canada be permitted to act on the Board.
