(d) that there should be no rule against the granting of licences for television stations to the operators of sound broadcasting stations or to the publishers of newspapers but that no preference be accorded to them;

(e) that the provisions of the Radio Act be applied, as in the case of radio stations, to keep multiple ownership of television stations to a minimum;

(f) that the Department of Transport and the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation maintain full information on the ownership of television stations and check carefully into proposed changes of control as provided for by the Radio Act;

(g) that the provisions of the Radio Act with regard to non-Canadian ownership of stations should apply in the case of television stations and that, while there was no objection to a foreign minority interest in Canadian stations, the regulations should be applied so as to avoid the establishment of a foreign controlling interest; and,

(h) that no change be made at the present time in the handling or accessibility of the financial returns of broadcasting stations which were provided to the Department of Transport.
