the other of such meetings an essay or address shall be delivered by some member appointed by the Chairman four weeks prior to such meeting and such member shall give the Society one weeks notice of the subject of such essay or address.

SECTION XXIV.

Public Meetings Public meetings may be held when thought desirable by this Society.

SECTION XXV.

Order of Business and variation of

The order of business at meetings shall be as follows (subject however to any alteration that may be made for the evening by a vote of the majority of the members present):—

- (1) Reading the minutes of last meeting.
- (2) Reading communications.
- (3) Notices of Motion.
- (4) Motions of which notice has been given.
- (5) Business from the Committee of Management and arising out of the minutes and communications and general business.
- (6) Election of officers.
- (7) Reading essays and selections.
- (8) Debates.
- (9) Criticism.
