

to be considered without reasonable excuse, from six consecutive meetings, constituting such neglect,) it shall be immediately filled by election.

(c) The ballots are to be counted by two scrutineers appointed by the Chair; a majority of all votes cast is necessary for an election.

ARTICLE IV.

DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

(a) The duty of the President is to preside at each regular meeting unless prevented by urgent outside duties, and to govern the same by impartial parliamentary ruling. At the end of his official year he shall present a retrospective report of the same.

(b) One of the Vice-Presidents shall assume the duties of the President in his absence.

(c) The Recording-Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings and attend to all the correspondence of the club.

(d) The Financial-Secretary shall keep correct accounts with members, collect their dues and fees and hand all money received over to the Treasurer against the Treasurer's receipt.

(e) The Treasurer shall receive all moneys and deposit same as provided for in the Constitution and
