## SUMMER SESSION, 1917

Courses leading to—

(a) Degree of Bachelor of Arts.

*First Year* —English, Latin, French or Biology, Algebra and Geometry, Trigonometry.

*Second Year*—English, Latin, French, History, Physics, Biology.

*Third Year* —English, French, History, Chemistry, Geology and Mineralogy.

*Fourth Year*—English, French, History, Chemistry, Geology and Mineralogy.

At the Summer Session, 1917, the following subjects will be offered:—

*First Year* —English, Algebra and Geometry, Trigonometry.

*Second Year*—Latin, History, Biology.

(b) Elementary Household Science Certificates.

(c) Admission to the Normal Schools (Middle School) Part A.

(d) Admission to the Faculties of Education (Upper School) Parts A and B.

(e) Elementary and Intermediate Manual Training Certificates.

(f) Elementary Commercial and Commercial Specialist Certificates.

(g) Elementary Vocal Music Certificates and Supervisors' Certificates.

(h) First Class Public School and High School Assistants' Certificates.

(i) Special Examination for Certificates as Public School Inspectors.

In addition to the above Courses there will be a Special Course in French pronunciation and conversation.
