WE, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Legislative Council and Representatives of Your People of Lower Canada, having taken into our most ferious confideration the neceffity of further continuing the provisions made by an Act paffed in the forty first year of Your Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for the es relief of Infane Perfons, and for the fupport of Foundlings," which faid Act provides for the fecuring and fupporting fuch indigent perfons as, from a temporary or lafting derangement of intellect, are incapable of earning their subsistence, for preventing the inhuman practice of exposing and deserting new born infants, and for granting aid and fupport to fuch Religious Communities as receive and maintain fick and infirm Perfons and Foundlings, do most humbly befeech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act " passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making . more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North Ameri-" ca;" and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province;" and it is hereby enacted by authority of the fame, that from and after the paffing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful to and for His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government of this Province for the time being, out of any unappropriated monies in the hands of the Receiver General of. this Province, to apply and appropriate a fum not exceeding One Thoufand Bounds per annum, for the relief of such unfortunate persons as may, from derangement of intellect, be meapable of earning their fustenance, and for the maintenance of fuch new perfons and found born infants as may be exposed or require protection, and for the aid and support of fuch Religious Communities as receive and administer relief to fick and infirm Perfons and Foundlings; and the faid fum herein appropriated shall be applied in such manner and under luch regulations as the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering
