### C A P. XVIII.

An Act further to continue for a limited time, and to amend a certain Act therein mentioned, relating to the Inferior District of Saint Francis.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient further to continue for a limited time and to amend the several Acts hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America,*" and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that a certain Act passed in the tenth and eleventh years of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to continue further for a limited time a certain Act passed in the third year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to erect certain Townships therein mentioned into an Inferior District, to be called the Inferior District of Saint Francis, and to establish Courts of Judicature therein, and to make further provision for the due Administration of Justice in the said Inferior District," shall be and remain in force until the expiration of this Act and no longer.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said District heretofore called the Inferior District of Saint Francis, shall be hereafter called the District of Saint Francis.
