Lands' Act.

A detailed statement of the Fees received and receivable under the 15, 36, and 37th Rules of the Supreme Court, with the Fees received for Bail Bonds, together with the Fees taken and received for Bonds of Indemnity, as well as all those Fees taken or received by virtue of, or as incident to, the Sheriff's Office, distinguishing the Fees taken and received or receivable in each case, shewing the names of the Plaintiff and Defendant, from 1st July, 1847, to 1st January, 1843, and from 1st January, 1848, inclusive, to 2d July, 1848, and from 2d July, 1848, inclusive, to 31st December, 1848, inclusive.

A detailed statement of all monies voted by the Legislature in the Supply Acts, in the years 1844, 1845, 1846, and 1847, unexpended and remaining in the hands of the Treasurer, showing the particular service for which such sum or sums were voted; also the sum or sums of money voted by the Legislature in the Road Acts in the years 1844, 1845, and 1846, for the making and repairing of Roads and Bridges, and unexpended, and remaining in the hands of the Treasurer on the 31st December, 1843 shewing the particular Line of Road and Bridge, and the District wherein situate.

A detailed statement of all monies received and paid by the Treasurer from the 31st December, 1847, to the 1st day of January, 1849, shewing the total amount received and paid for each particular service, duly classified—say, Education, &c., &c., &c., : together with the amount remaining in the Treasurer's hands on the said 1st January, and a detailed statement of all outstanding claims which the Government is pledged to pay.

A statement shewing the gross receipts of Imperial and Colonial Reveuncollected and received in each Port of Entry in this Island; and a detailed statement of the costs and charges incurred in the collection of the same in each Port of Entry, shewing the name and salary, fees and perquisites of the respective officers and others in each port, whether Imperial or Colanial appointment; also the gross amount of Light Dues collected in each Port of Entry, shewing the costs and charges incurred in collecting the same in each port, and the nett sum paid to the Treasurer.

A statement shewing the gross amount of Revenue collected in the Port of St. John's under 10 Vic., Chap. — namely, that Revenue arising out of half per cent. on the gross Revenue collected at the Customs in the port aforesaid; and a detailed statement shewing the expenditure of the said Revenue from the 14th January, 1847, to the 1st January, 1848, and from the 1st January, 1848, to the 1st January, 1849.
