

Act to the *General Aſſembly*, at their reſpective Seſſions, and it ſhall and may be lawful for ſaid Commiſſioners to nominate to the Seſſions of the Peace for the Counties of *Halifax* and *Hants*, ſo many fit and proper Perſons as they the ſaid Commiſſioners ſhall think neceſſary, who ſhall be appointed Overſeers of the Highway between the ſaid *Sackville Bridge*, and the ſaid *Three Mile Plain* by ſaid *Seſſions of the Peace*, and ſaid Overſeers after being ſo appointed ſhall have full Power and Authority to execute all the Laws heretofore in Force, relative to the Repair of Highways in as full and ample a Manner as if ſuch Perſon or Perſons had been appointed Overſeers in the Manner and Form heretofore uſual and cuſtomary.

Commiſſioners to nominate Overſeers of ſaid Road to be appointed by the Court of Seſſions.

V. *And be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforeſaid*, That out of the Monies firſt raiſed or collected by this Act, the ſaid Commiſſioners ſhall and may appropriate for paying the Expences of making an accurate Survey of the Road a Sum not exceeding Twenty Pounds, and that a Poundage of *Seven and a half per Centum*, and no more ſhall be allowed and paid by ſaid Commiſſioners to the Perſons employed by them in the Execution of this Act, either as Collectors or Overſeers of ſaid Road in ſuch Proportions as they may judge proper.

Commiſſioners to appropriate £20. for making a Survey.

$7\frac{1}{2}$ per Cent allowed to Collectors or Overſeers of ſaid Road.

VI. *And be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforeſaid*, That if any Perſon or Perſons having or owning any unfettled Lot or Lots of Land or Lands on ſaid *Windsor Road*, between the ſaid *Sackville Bridge* and the ſaid *Three Mile Plain*, and who ſhall neglect to ſettle the ſame in the Manner herein before mentioned, or to pay the ſaid Rate or Tax of three Pounds yearly for every Quarter of a Mile Front, and ſo in Proportion for a Lot of leſs Front, it ſhall and may be lawful for ſuch Commiſſioners or any two of them, when one Year's Tax or Rate ſhall become due and owing by any Perſon or Perſons for, or on Account of any unfettled Lot or Piece of Land on ſaid Road, to advertize in the public News Papers of *Halifax*, ſo much of ſuch Lot or Tract of Land as ſhall be required for the Payment of the ſaid Rate or Tax together with the Charges of ſuch Sale at ſome convenient Place in the Town of *Halifax*, and after advertiſing the ſame weekly during ſix Weeks, in at leaſt two News Papers, if no Perſon appears to pay off and diſcharge the ſaid Rate or Tax together with the Expence of advertiſing, then it ſhall and may be lawful for ſaid Commiſſioners to ſet up and ſell at Public Auction to the higheſt Bidder, ſo much of ſuch Lot or Piece or Parcel of Land as aforeſaid, and to execute to ſuch Purchaſer or Purchaſers a Deed of Bargain and Sale for the Purpose of conveying to him, his Heirs and Aſſigns, a good and ſufficient Eſtate in Fee Simple therein, and every Part thereof, and ſuch Purchaſer or Purchaſers Tittle, in and to the Lands ſo conveyed to him, ſhall be good and ſufficient in Law, notwithstanding any Defect in the Form thereof.

Commiſſioners empowered to ſell the unfettled Lots of ſuch Proprietors as neglect to pay the Tax.

And to make Deeds to the Purchaſers.
