A DRASTIC BILL REPORTED BY THE POHOUSE COMMITTER AT WASHINGTON;

Washington, Dec. 20. A drastic bill denying the use of the United States mail to advertisements of in toxicating liquors, whether printed in newspapers, magazines, circulars, or otherwise, was reported to the bouse committee on post offices. Representative C. H. Raufell, of Californis, a Prohibitionist-Democrat, is the author of this measure.

'The purpose of this bill,' said Mr., Randall, 'is to close the mails absolutely to advertising before the public of intoxicating liquors, and to deny mail order liquor houses, of which there are more than Lose, the right to go into either wet or dry territory, and override local liquor regulations by soliciting sales through the medium of the mails.
