On no account let them get chilled, ther by being taken out, or the doors sing left open; but see also that the able is kept perfectly clean, all manure mediately removed, and the floors well usted with carbolic powder.

And may I add to the owners—If you ish to save the lives of your horses, do not tree the poor staggering animals to work, twen if they do not drop dead on the treets, as many have done, and supposing ven they do not die from the disease, are injury done to the lungs and system enerally will render them almost worthses. Old horses more especially seem or suffer from the congested condition of ne lungs and weakened circulation, and equire all care possible.
