U. F. O. CAMPAIGN IS OPENED IN GREY COUNTY

Durham, Oct. 21.—The first political gun in Grey County was fired yesterday, when the U. F. O.-Progressive party held their campaign meeting in Durham. The hall was filled to the door and half the audience were ladies. Mayor Allan occupied the chair. The speakers were the candidate, Miss Agnes C. McPhail and J. J. Morrison, provincial U. F. O. secretary. Miss McPhail spoke for over three-quarters of an hour and gave a resume of her life and also her lineage on both sides of the house. Mr. Morrison followed for the hour, and referred to the piles of letters he had in his office asking for Miss McPhail to address various campaign meetings, but as this was impossible they were bringing Miss McPhail east from Manitoba for that work.
