

Municipal Debentures

It looks very much as if the days for the sale of debentures bearing interest at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum is a thing of the past, as many municipalities which have ssued debentures bearing that rate of interest are finding no buyers. Brokers will not touch any debentures that call for less than $5\frac{1}{2}$ or 6 per cent. The town of Strathroy issued \$40,000 worth 5 per cent. Brokers "just smiled" at 5 per cent. and there was "nothing doing." The town finally sold them for \$36,000, a loss of \$4,000. Leamington is also offering some 5 per cent. debentures. No buyers. Next comes Colchester South with \$29,-800 worth of drainage debentures
