Pl. Ka-ks-aimti. 2. P-ks-aimti. 3. Ks-aiimti.

Present Continue.

1. Chi-kaes-aimti, I must always get mad. 2. Ku-kaes-aimti. 3. Kaes-aimti.

Pl. Ka-kaes-aimti. 2. P-Kaes-aimti. 3. Kaes-aiimti.

Perfect 1st.

Chi-ks-aimt, I must be mad.

Perfect 2d.

Eu lshen u chin-aimt, When I was mad.

Perfect 3d.

Eu lshen u chin-uis-aimt, When I had done being mad, after I had been mad.

Perfect 4th.

Chi-ka-ep-saimt, I must have some anger.

Future 1st.

Ne chin-aimt, When I shall be mad.

Future 2d.

Ne chiks-aimti, When I shall want to get mad, when I shall be obliged to get mad.

Future 3d.

Ne chi-ks-aimt, When I shall have been compelled to be mad.

Future 4th.

Ne chin-uis-aimt, After I shall have been mad.

Chi-ks-tilemi, I must die.

Present.

Chi-kaes-tilemi, I must always die, etc.

Perfect 1st.

Chi-ks-tlil, I must be dead.

Perfect 2d.

Eu l shei u chin-tlil, When I died.

Perfect 3d.

Eu l shei u chin-uis-tlil, After I had died.

Future 1st.

Ne chin-tlil, When I shall be dead.

Future 2d.

Ne chi-ks-tilemi, When I shall be bound to die.

Future 3d.

Ne chi-ks-tlil, When I shall be dead.

Future 4th.

Ne chin-uis-tlil, After I shall have died.
