The regular course of study leads to the degrees of M.D., C.M. Double courses leading to the degrees of B.A. or B.Sc. and M.D., C.M. may be taken. A course of Dentistry leading to the degree of D.D.S.

In addition there are:

Advanced courses to graduates and others desiring to pursue special or research work in the laboratories of the University or in those of the Royal Victoria and Montreal General Hospitals.

A practical course of lectures of from six to twelve months duration to graduates in Medicine and Public Health Officers for the Diploma of Public Health.

A course in Pharmacy for the Diploma in Pharmacy (this course satisfying the requirements of the Pharmaceutical Association of the Province of Quebec.)
