

EXCHANGE OF NOTES (December 10, 1965) BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AMENDING THE SCHEDULE TO THE AIR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES OF SEPTEMBER 4, 1959.

EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes of September 4, 1959,⁽¹⁾ in reference to Paragraph 2 Article II of the Air Transport Agreement between Canada and the Federal Republic of Germany signed at Ottawa on the same date, and to propose on behalf of my Government that the following arrangement be concluded to amend the said Exchange of Notes: In Part II, third column, the word "Düsseldorf" shall be replaced by the word "Frankfurt".

If the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany agrees to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply thereto expressing the agreement of your Government shall constitute an arrangement between our two governments to enter into force on the date of your reply.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
