Tariff Impacts of Free Trade

U.S. tariffs on pleasure boats ranged from 1.5% to 4%. Canoes are duty free. Under the Free Trade Agreement, all tariffs will be removed by January 1, 1998, with ten equal stages of tariff reductions.

Tariff Impacts of Free Trade

U.S. tariffs on pumps ranged from 2.5% to 3.7% unless intended for installation in civil aircraft or motor vehicles, in which case these items are duty free. Under the Free Trade Agreement, all pumps will become duty free on January 1, 1993, with duties reduced in five equal stages.
