Together with the Department and the host organizations, they strive to ensure that each internship is a valuable international experience that enhances the intern's marketability.

If an organization has international contacts and would like to develop and administer a project placing *five* or more interns, it should communicate with the Department using the contact information given at the end of this brochure.

HOST OBGANIZATIONS WHO ARE THEY?

They are Canadian or foreign companies, non-governmental organizations, and international organizations which value the talent, skills, innovative ideas and energy of youth of Canada.

WHAT DO THEY DO?

Host organizations provide full-time international assignments of 6-12 months duration.
