The Department of External Affairs announced today that the Minister of External Affairs of Pakistan, Mr. Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, who has been attending the General Assembly in New York as leader of the Pakistan Delegation, would pay a courtesy visit to Ottawa September 30 to October 2.

His programme in Ottawa will include meetings with the Prime Minister, the Right Honourable Lester B. Pearson and the Minister of Industry and Acting Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable C.M. Drury. The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin, will be in New York where he has had discussions with Mr. Bhutto.

Mr. Bhutto will hold a press conference at 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday, October 2 (Large Conference Room, East Block).
