

MICHEL DUPUY

Mr. Dupuy was born in Paris on January 11, 1930. He studied at Stanislas College (Baccalauréat), Oxford University (B.A.), Institute of Political Studies in Paris (Diploma), the University of Paris (Doctorate in International Law). He joined the Privy Council Office in 1954 and entered the Department of External Affairs in 1955. He has served at the Canadian Embassy in Washington; the Canadian Embassy, Brussels, and the Mission of Canada to the European Communities; and at the Delegation of Canada to the North Atlantic Council.

Since September 1969 he has been Director General of the Department's Office of Economic Affairs, Ottawa. He is married to the former Beatriz Cuervo Yepes and has two children.

Mr. Halstead was born in Vancouver on January 27, 1922. He studied at the University of British Columbia (B.A.), and the London School of Economics (B.Sc.).
