2.	Subsection 32.3(1)	<p>All that portion of subsection 32.3(1) of the said Act following paragraph (b) thereof is repealed and the following substituted:</p> <p>“is guilty of an indictable offence and is liable to a fine in the discretion of the court or to imprisonment for five years or to both.”</p>
3.	Subsection 36.2(2)	<p>Subsection 36.2(2) of the said Act is repealed and the following substituted:</p> <p>“(2) Any person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of ten thousand dollars or to imprisonment for one year or to both.”</p>
4.	Subsection 37(4)	<p>Subsection 37(4) of the said Act is repealed and the following substituted:</p> <p>“(4) Any person who violates subsection (2) is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of twenty-five thousand dollars or to imprisonment for one year or to both.”</p>
5.	Subsection 37.1(2)	<p>Subsection 37.1(2) of the said Act is repealed and the following substituted:</p> <p>“(2) Any person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of twenty-five thousand dollars or to imprisonment for one year or to both.”</p>
6.	Subsection 38(8)	<p>Subsection 38(8) of the said Act is repealed and the following substituted:</p> <p>“(8) Every person who violates subsection (1) or (6) is guilty of an indictable offence and is liable to a fine in the discretion of the court or to imprisonment for five years or to both.”</p>
