No provisions for paying special allowances to widowers appear in the new British regulations, but it is expected that the allowances paid to a man with a dependent parent, or to a married man, will be paid according to the merits of individual cases.

1. The allowance of \$80.81 is the maximum and is payable in cases where there are five or more children.
2. The above amounts are inclusive of pension.
3. Men undergoing training in industries, except apprentices, are not paid the above rates, but are given allowances by the Government which will bring up the amount earned by the trainee to the minimum journeyman's rate for the district, exclusive of pension.
4. Apprentices who have resumed their indentures are not paid above rates, but receive allowances which, with pension and amount earned, will equal the wage they would have earned had apprenticeship not been interrupted.

1. The allowance of \$68.82 is the maximum and is payable in cases where there are four or more children.
2. Men receiving training in Technical schools, and students, receiving training in Professional or Commercial occupations receive the lower rate inclusive of pension. Apprentices who have resumed their indentures receive the higher rate inclusive of pension. Approved trainees in private workshops receive the higher rate exclusive of pension. In all cases payments by employers are deducted.
