Obviously 9 o'clock lectures are distasteful.

Alternation with Mathematics 1 was retained in the time table complained of, although the days were alternated instead of hours in the same days. A later letter (see Appendix, Section 5) from Prof. duRoure states that the existing time table of the French Department is not wholly satisfactory.

On letter of Nov. 30th.

French 15 was withheld from the skeleton time table since it exists only for B.Sc. students and other times could be arranged for it.

The final time table schedule leaves this Department wholly undisturbed.
