There was a rush of speculators to the Lambton swales and hardwood forests to dig for oil when the news of Williams' discovery got out; and the rush was accentuated when a similar discovery in Pennsylvania was noised abroad.

First Rumor Died Down.
The early drilling, undertaken by the nost primitive methods and carried to no very great depths, developed no spectacular discoveries. A little oil was secured in a number of shallow wells, some at Oil Springs and others at Petrolea. Interest in the Lambton fields was, however, on the wane by the early


