Learn took possession of the farm owned by Mrs. Helmer in August, 1919, by written agreement of lease, he declared. The lease was signed by Mary Ann Helmer, mother of accused. Later the crown will show that the prisoner became more and more uneasy and that he sent to his mother at Sparta for a copy of the lease held by Learn. On July 12 last he took it to John S. Abel, police magistrate, to ascertain if Learn could be gotten off the place.
