The Annual Congregational Meeting was held in the Lecture Room on the evening of Wednesday the thirteenth day of February, 1889.

The Pastor opened the meeting with reading of Scripture, and prayer.

He immediately afterward called for nomination of Chairman.

It was moved and unanimously adopted that Mr. R. K. Chisholm preside.

The minutes of last Annual Meeting were read and approved, and also the minutes of a subsequent Congregational Meeting were approved.

The Moderator read the Report of the Session to the Congregation, which was adopted, and considerably abbreviated is as follows:

General good health has prevailed during the year, though many of the church members have passed through varied sickness, and two have died, Capt. Robt. Wilson on the 22nd of May, Mrs. C. Marlatt on 22nd December. These have passed to the upper sanctuary. Our new church was opened on the 20th of May, and we have had great comfort in worshipping in its ample and elegant auditorium, and in using its commodious and convenient school rooms.

The communion has been observed four times during the year; twenty-seven persons have been admitted to the membership of the Church; fifteen have been dismissed.
