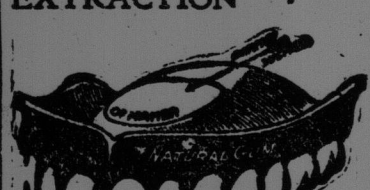
IMPROVED TRAIN SERVICE WOODSTOCK-AROOSTOOK

Effective after June 26th Canadian Pacific trains 158 and 154, now operating St. Stephen to Woodstock and return, will be extended to run as far north as Aroostook. Train 154 will leave Aroostook at 4:10 a. m. Eastern Standard and on through to McAdam, making connection at that point with all trains east and southbound. Returning train 158, connecting at McAdam with all evening trains will leave Woodstock at 9:00 p. m. and arrive Aroostook at 11:30 p. m.

URGES BRITISH FACTORIES FOR THE DOMINION

Ottawa, June 27.—(Canadian Press)—The creation of British factories in the Dominion in order to secure for the United Kingdom a share in the "great industrial future of Canada" is advocated by Sir Peter Hildes, president of the Federation of British Industries, in a contribution to the Weekly Bulletin of the department of trades and commerce. He urges increased trade between the United Kingdom and Canada, and the investment of British capital in the Dominion. He proposes the services of the federation's officials in their various centres, on behalf of Canadian business men visiting the United Kingdom.

MIRROR ON HOOK MAKES FISH AID IN CAPTURE

Oswego, N. Y., June 27.—No more empty baskets for fishermen. That's what the invention of J. F. Anderson—a hook with bait attached—promises. For some months he has been experimenting with a small looking glass that goes into the water just behind the baited hook. The fish, attracted by the reflected light from the mirror, investigates. Then he sees a big angle worm squirming in the water, and the reflection of another fish in the water about to snatch it away. It becomes a question as to who gets it first, and the result is that the sucker is hooked.

Cleveland, June 27.—Wm. H. McGannon, former chief justice of the municipal court, was found guilty of perjury on Saturday night by the jury which heard his case in common pleas, Judge Florence E. Allan's court. The penalty is from one to ten years in the penitentiary.

WORKS OF REMBRANT KEEP COMING TO LIGHT

Berlin, June 27.—At least 100 previously unknown pictures by Rembrandt, the Dutch master, have been discovered in the last ten years, most of them through the persistent efforts of art dealers. Within one week two Rembrandt paintings—one of Susanna, the other of St. Peter with the warriors—were brought to light, the first one in the Habersroh Galleries, the other in the von Diemen Galleries.

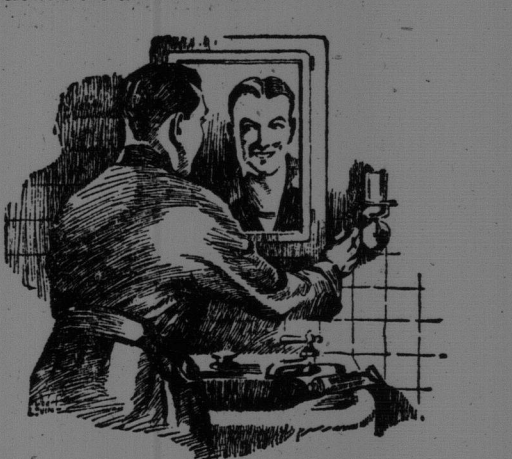
