WILL NOT MAKE ST. JOHN A CENTRE

Evangelical Alliance Hears Report on Men and Religion Movement—Again Against Sunday Funerals

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PRESIDENT TAFT FOR COMMISSION

Favors Placing Responsibility for Municipal Administration on Small Body of Men

Hutchinson, Kan., Oct. 1.—In laying the cornerstone of the new city building here last week, President Taft announced his belief in the theory of the modern view of municipal administration upon one man, or upon a very small body of men.

Mr. Taft came very close to advocating openly the commission form of government.

"Experiments," he said, "have been made as to the character of the best municipal government. I think the general tendency of the modern view is that the municipal government is best at least for cities of any considerable size, which fixes the responsibility upon a small body of men and makes them answer to the whole people of the city for the efficiency of the government."

of the Mohammedans of India, urging Great Britain to take a hand in the Italian-Turkish situation. The message was addressed to the foreign secretary at London, and a duplicate went by telegraph to the Indian home secretary at Simla. It was dispatched at the instigation of a mass meeting of Mohammedans held here, and asked England, as "the greatest Mohammedan power in the world," to check Italy's career of aggression.

Another message from the same source went forward to the grand vizier at Constantinople, urging that Turkey defend the honor of Islam.

That the Mohammedans of India are thoroughly aroused, is indicated by the mass meetings held in forming a strong committee styled the Indian red crescent society, which proposes to take such steps as seem advisable to prevent war.

Although the passengers boarded the Castlegarth Friday morning, the vessel did not leave Tripoli until 11 o'clock Saturday night.

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
