method adopted, and now well known, the round sum of two thousand dollars has been deposited in the Merchants' Bank, to be handed when required to the Managers of the church. The balance, \$114.37 is reserved, to be added to the sum expected to be raised in the same way during 1894 for the same purpose.

The Association has also relieved the managers of the payment of about \$300 for a new furnace and extra coils which were required for the Manse.

The Association give thanks to God for whatever of help they have been enabled to render the church, and have joy in the reflection that, though their meetings have been many and the subjects brought before them varied, perfect harmony has been maintained throughout the year.
