Q-2. Are you guilty or not guilty of the [first] charge against you, which you have heard read? Question to the accused.

Q-3. Are you guilty or not guilty of the second charge against you, which you have heard read? Question.

Q-4. Are you guilty or not guilty of the third charge against you, which you have heard read? Question.

Q-5. Are you guilty or not guilty of the fourth charge against you, which you have heard read? Question.

A-5. *Not Guilty* Answer.
A-6. *Are you guilty or not guilty of the fifth charge against you, which you have heard read.* Question.
