The last day for registration for Spring Session 1975 is April 1. Summer Session 1975 commences July 2 and ends August 12 with the First Term running from July 2 to July 22 and the Second Term running from July 23 to August 12. The last day for registration for Summer Session 1975 is April 30. Students who have not previously attended the University of Alberta should present their Application for Admission and supporting documentation to the Office of the Registrar by March 1 for Spring Session and April 1 for Summer Session in order to ensure processing.
