Sir

In consequence of public advertisements calling upon parties claiming to have any interest or title to any Lot in the tract of Land known as the St Regis Indian Reservation in the County of Glengarry to file a written statement of the particulars of their respective claims in the Office of the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs in Montreal, I now beg to submit the following statement

Edw. McCall
In the year 1823 my father, now deceased, purchased from Donald Cameron his right of possession to Lots 8013. 14. & 15 which lots have since been possessed by him, myself and brother and upon each of which we have made clearings to the extent of on Lot No 13. 24 acres on Lot No 14 - 23 acres and on Lot No 15 - 15 acres

I am given to understand that Mr. Alexander McKerracher claims the rear part of Lot No 13 but as my possession was long anterior to his or John Henrys Tapon which Mr McKerracher founds, I conceive that I have the best right to claim the land
