Education for Political Life

Education for political life will help women overcome the difficulties and attitudes that deter them from participating. Specially geared courses should start at high school level to prepare girls for political positions, either appointed or elected ones. Political activity at school should be allowed. Student participation at planning meetings of school boards, at seminars, in local and higher levels of government should be encouraged.
