If the vouchers were satisfactory such remarks as the foregoing would seem unnecessary, but when the points which I am about to raise are considered the gravity of the offense will be more apparent.

Voucher No 4121. The Assist' Comr has said with reference to this voucher, that it is forwarded for the purpose of making good the amount Mr. Mc Donald paid himself out of his annuity cash, as he has cashed the voucher himself. Two interpretations can be placed upon this clause, but it is the desire of the Department to put the more favorable one forward, as no doubt explanations will be furnished that will clear the transaction.
