



Ottawa 2nd February, 1905.

Revd Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th instant, submitting a statement of relief supplies furnished to destitute and sick Indians of your Agency, and shewing thereon the respective amounts due the merchants who furnished the goods; and in reply I beg to say that this manner of rendering accounts is not satisfactory to the Department. I enclose herewith a supply of the Departmental account forms. Kindly have the parties who supplied the flour and beef render their accounts thereon, in detail and in duplicate, after which you should certify to the same, if correct, and transmit to Headquarters. Upon receipt of the same in proper form the matter of payment will at once be dealt with.
