Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant, reporting that Albert Tobias the guardian of the sons of the late Seth Lacelles states that the only money which he has collected in connection with the estate of the deceased was the sum of \$7.00, which amount was paid to him by A.W. Logan, on account of the purchase of a horse; and in reply I beg to say that you should get Tobias to pay over this money to you and forward it to the Department. You should also obtain from him, and send to Headquarters, a statement of the price of the horse which he sold to Logan. If Logan still owes a balance thereon you should collect it and forward it also.

The Department desires that you will make enquiries amongst the Indians as to the disposition of the chattels belonging to the estate.
