



Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 21st instant, relative to the advance of \$100.00 made you to defray expenses in connection with the Stryen Creek Bridge; and in reply I have to remind you that the Department will hold you responsible for the amount of cheque until you produce proper vouchers and receipts for the expenditure of the same.
