- (i) Members may be elected to any other sub-council after the expiration of one (1) year.
- (j) No member of any sub-council shall deputize on any sub-council under any circumstances.
- (k) No member shall serve on more than one sub-council in any capacity. <u>EXCEPTION</u>:-- Regional Control sub-councils, where the member's own nation is directly concerned. Regional Control subpcouncils are of a temporary nature, being formed as and when required to deal with special problems between the nations concerned.
- (1) Where a member of any sub-council is absent through unavoidable causes, then a temporary member may be elected to the sub-council from the remaining members of the International Court to act as deputy for the absent member.
- (m) Such deputy member shall be elected from the same party as that to which the absent member belongs,

but shall be of different nationality.

- (n) No member shall be allowed to deputize for any absent member of the International Court on the same sub-council more than once in any one (1) yr.
- No deputy member of any sub-council shall be allowed to hold office in the same sub-council for any period exceeding three (3) months.
