

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

in the case of

E 4361 Private P.E. PLANTE, Royal 22e Regiment, a soldier of
the Canadian Army, Overseas.

Evidence taken on oath by order of the Commanding Officer.

FIRST WITNESS E 5505 Corporal P.GIRARD, Royal 22e Regiment, having been
FOR PROSECUTION duly sworn states:-

" I am and was at all times material hereto a Corporal of the Royal 22e Regiment posted to "C" Company. On the 22nd of June 43, between 2130 and 2145 hours, I was sitting in the recreation room on Ship A-9 when suddenly I felt my steel helmet being grabbed from behind me and pushed over to the back of my head. At the same time I was hit by a man's fist on the right side of my right eye. After which I was hit four or five times again and whilst I was trying to get up, my chin strap broke. I then fell down and soon as I turned to face him.

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.

SECOND WITNESS E 57856 L/Corporal MICHAEL T., Royal 22e Regiment, having
FOR PROSECUTION been duly sworn states:-

" I am and was at all times material hereto a lance-corporal of the Royal 22e Regiment posted to "C" Company. During the evening of the 22 of June, 1943, I was standing near the piano in the recreation room on ship A-9 when suddenly I heard a commotion in the adjoining room. I immediately went over to see what was happening, and there I saw Private Plante holding the Corporal Girard by the collar of his tunic and hitting him at the same time. Corporal Girard eventually got up and Private Plante went away.

The accused declines to cross-examine the above witness.

The accused was duly warned in accordance with R.P. 4 (E) but declines to make a statement and reserves his defence.

The evidence was taken down by the undersigned in the presence and within the hearing of the accused in the Field on the 23rd day of June, 1943.
