

Referring to your letter of the 9th inst., enclosing copy of letter from Mr. C.E. Webb of the Dominion Water and Power Bureau, together with their report on the domestic water supply on Chekwelp Indian Reserve No.26, it would appear that the only satisfactory solution is to re-locate a portion of the pipeline along the road allowances, to avoid encroachment upon private property.

The original Band resolution of March 18th, 1927 provided that cost of installation of the water system be charged against Squamish Band funds, without mentioning any specific amount.

It would have been better if the resolution had covered maintenance and future repairs and alterations.

If you do not consider that this was the intent, it will be necessary for me to secure a new resolution from the Band at the next Council meeting, which I hope to call early next month.
