Replying to your letter of the 28th ultimo with reference to employment of Indians in your Agency, I would advise that I have referred same to Mr. Indian Agent Gillett with the request that he communicate with you direct in the matter if such work is available in his district.

You should instruct your Indians to advise you immediately they receive a notice from the Army to report for a medical examination in order to enable you to write me, in duplicate, setting out the circumstances preventing their reporting for medical examination except at a prohibitive cost, under which circumstances I feel sure the Divisional Registrar will grant postponement until such time as the examination could be taken without undue expense.
