CARHOLME. A village on Big creek (which furnishes power) in Walsingham township, Norfolk County, 12 miles south-west of Simcoe, the county seat, and nearest bank location, and 10 south of Delhi, on the G W div G T Ry, its nearest shipping point. Settled in 1882. It has a Presbyterian church and common school, and ships live stock, cheese, grain, flour and produce. It is on the stage route from Walsh to Lynedoch and Delhi. Population, 100. Mail daily. James Smith, postmaster.

CARLETON PLACE. A flourishing village, on the Mississippi river (which affords power), and on the C P Ry, in Beckwith township, Lanark County, 20 miles north of Perth, the county seat. Settled in 1818, and incorporated in 1870, it has woolen, saw and flour mills, foundries, machine and C P Ry shops, etc, and contains Episcopal, Presbyterian, Catholic, Baptist and Methodist churches, a high and two public schools, with 550 pupils, a mechanics' institute, with a library of 400 volumes, a bank,

and two weekly newspapers, the *Herald* and the *Central Canadian*. Lumber and woollen goods are shipped. Electric light and telephone system in use. Assessed valuation of real and personal property, \$501,550; bonded indebtedness, \$6,600. Steamboats run to Innisville, on Lake Mississippi, about 12 miles distant. Lead is found in the vicinity. Stages daily to Lanark, 18 miles, fare \$1, and Appleton, 4 miles, fare 25c. Population, 3,000. Telegraph, GNW. Express, Dominion. Mail daily. Distance from Ottawa, 28 miles, from Toronto, 231 miles.
