The House divided upon the question,

And the same being carried by a majority of five,

ORDERED, that the faid Proviso be added to, and follow the first Proviso of the Engrossed Bill.

Mr. Lees moved, seconded by Mr. Fisher, to resolve that the following clause be added to the Bill:—" And be it surther enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall be in sorce to the first day of January which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three, and from thence to the end of the then next session of the Provincial Parliament and no longer.
