Citizenship.

The action of the British Government in revoking the citizenship of Edgar Speyer is a reminder to the country of principles which are overlooked and even injudiciously applied. One is that naturalization is not as an inalienable privilege, but as a privilege, and only in recognition of the fulfillment and maintenance of certain conditions. If a naturalized citizen fails to maintain these conditions the naturalization may be lapsed. Moreover, native birth, in its fullest functions, is an inalienable and inalienable privilege. The mere fact that it is automatically entered into by the great majority of persons on attaining the age of twenty-one years, without examination or other formality, does not mean that everyone is entitled to it, and anybody can be deprived of it. 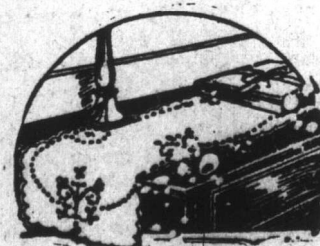

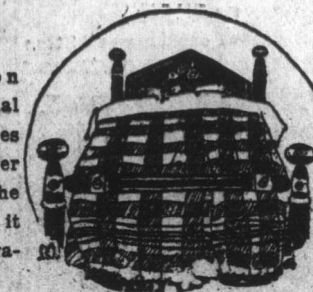
